Book Bags

To make finding it easier you can attach one small key ring to the handle. Please bring your book bag to school every day.

Birthdays

If your birthday is on a school day you can come to school dressed in your own favourite clothes. You can also bring in small bags of sweets, such as Haribo to give to the children in the class if you would like to.
