Welcome to Year 6. This is a really important year as it is your last year in Primary School. You will be expected to be more independent, take on more responsibility for your own learning and as the oldest children in the school, we hope that you will strive to set an excellent example to our younger children by being good role models. All of this will help to prepare you for the transition to Secondary School.

In Eagle Owls, you will be responsible for organising and taking care of your own belongings and making sure you have all the things you need ready to learn. **Reading books will be required to be in school every day.**

You will also get your own planner, which you will use to record your homework in. This is really important as you will need to make sure you know what to do, as well as when it is due in.

Daily and weekly routines

Every morning, upon entering the classroom, you will be expected to hang your satchel and coat tidily on your peg and place your water bottle in the box. You will be asked to engage in a starter activity whilst we settle into our learning for the day.

These are the things you need to remember each week:

Tuesday – Come in PE kit. Spellings set and test the following week. Homework due in.

Wednesday – Come in PE kit. Piano lessons

Thursday – Homework set. String lessons. Brass lessons.

Please read at least 5 times a week for at least 20 minutes and sign your diary to be entered into the reading raffle.

Keep practising on Times Tables Rock Stars and Spelling Shed. This year as well as the reading raffle we will be running a spelling raffle. You will be entered into the spelling raffle each week if you get all of your spellings correct.

Year 6 SATs

Year 6 will sit their SATs in May 2023 and although they are important, there is absolutely no need to worry about them. We will work together to prepare during class time and through homework. You will sit tests in the following:

-  Reading
-  Grammar, including a spelling test
-  Arithmetic
-  Two maths reasoning papers

You will also be assessed by Miss Franklin for writing.
