Year 6

Year 6 is an important year for many reasons. It is your last year in Primary School, you will sit your SATs, and you will be thinking about moving onto Secondary school. As the oldest in the school, you will be expected to set an example to younger children, and help them when they need help.

There will also be plenty of opportunities for you to enjoy your final year and take part in many extra-curricular activities. This includes sports tournaments, the Education East Africa project, Cluster Orchestra, Science days, transfer days and trips. Please try to join in with all that you can, learning that takes place outside the classroom is important in creating a well-rounded student, ready for Secondary School.

Daily and weekly routines

Every day will start in the same way with a handwriting or spelling task. You will be expected to put your belongings tidily away before you sit down in the morning, and take all relevant belongings home at the end of the day. You will be responsible for your belongings, so make sure that you know where they are at all times!

You will need your PE kit on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Each week you will be set two pieces of homework, as well as spellings and readings.

Spellings – set on Wednesday, test on Tuesday

What will you need for Year 6?

You will need to bring a **small** pencil case to school, and it should include the following things:

-  Pencils
-  Ruler, at least 15cm long
-  Rubber and pencil sharpener
-  Glue stick
-  For those who have earned their pen licence: an ink pen (e.g. friction pen, fountain pen, handwriting pen) and a spare, in blue or black. **No ballpoints please.**

-  Highlighter
-  Purple pen
-  Paperclips, for guidelines

SATs

You will sit your SATs in May this year. We will spend some time preparing for these assessments, but you should not need to do additional preparation besides our normal classwork and homework. You will sit the following SATs papers:

-  Reading
-  SPAG, including a spelling test
-  Arithmetic
-  Two maths reasoning papers

You will also be assessed by Mrs Campbell for Writing. At various times throughout the year, we will do some practice tests so you are comfortable with the papers and know what to do.
