Year 5

There will be many new things for you to experience in Year 5. You will have your new uniform to wear, including a tie, which you will need to learn to tie by yourself. Please make sure you name your jumper and tie clearly, so they do not get muddled up.

What will you need for Year 5?

You will need to bring a **small** pencil case to school, and it should include the following things:

-  Pencils
-  Ruler, at least 15cm long
-  Rubber and pencil sharpener
-  Glue stick
-  For those who have earned their pen licence: an ink pen (e.g. friction pen, fountain pen, handwriting pen) and a spare, in blue or black. **No ballpoint pens please.**

It may be useful to have the following items, but they are not necessary:

-  Colouring pencils and/or pens
-  Highlighter
-  Purple pen
-  Paperclips, for guidelines

Daily and weekly routines

Every day will start in the same way with a handwriting or spelling task. You will be expected to put your belongings tidily away before you sit down in the morning, and take all relevant belongings home at the end of the day. You will be responsible for your belongings, so make sure that you know where they are at all times!

You will need your PE kit on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Each week you will be set two pieces of homework, as well as spellings and readings.

Literacy – set on a Monday, due in on Thursday

Numeracy – set on a Thursday, due in on Wednesday

Spellings – set on Wednesday, test on Tuesday

Reading – at least 5 times a week

TTRockStars/Spelling Shed – for extra support when necessary
